

PRIVACY POLICY

CHAPTER I - PERSONAL DATA

1. T.Riverwood Sp. z o. o. with its registered office in Warsaw [postcode 03 - 976], ul. Berneńska 3b NIP: 1132915027 REGON: 365060539, entered in the National Court Register kept by the COURT REGION FOR MST.WARSZAWA in WARSAW, XIII FACULTY OF ECONOMIC JUDICIAL REGISTRATION as the Privacy Officer of the bogoakshop.com; riverwood.eu Online Store, cares about the security of the data provided, in particular against unauthorized access.
2. T.RIVERWOOD provides all registered clients with the rights resulting from the Data Protection Act of 29 August 1997 (Journal of Laws of 2002, No. 101, item 926, as amended), in particular the right to inspect own data, the right to request updates and deletions of data, the right to revoke the consent to the processing of personal data and the right to object in the cases specified in the provisions of this law.
3. RIVERWOOD processes the personal data of the Customer solely for the purpose of proper implementation of the Services set forth in the Terms of Service of the Online Shop bogoakshop.com; riverwood.eu, using your personal data, including your name, address, telephone number, email address, pursuant to the Act of 18 July 2002 on the provision of services by electronic means (Journal of Laws No. 144, item 1204 as amended).
4. The personal data of the registering customer is processed for the entire duration of his Account at bogoakshop.com; riverwood.eu.
5. T.RIVERWOOD may also process other data than personal data that is not necessary for the performance of the service solely with prior consent of the Customer, expressed after T.RIVERWOOD has notified the data category, purpose and scope of processing. Such consent may be revoked at any time.
6. T.RIVERWOOD is in possession of IP addresses of Clients stored by T.RIVERWOOD for the duration of the Service, as well as information on the commencement, termination and use of the electronic service.
7. T.RIVERWOOD may also process the following data describing the way Customer uses the electronic delivery service (operating data):
 1. Signs identifying the Client, based on the registration form;
 2. Signs identifying the termination of the telecommunications network or teleinformatic system used by the Customer;
 3. information on the commencement, completion and the scope of each use of the service provided by electronic means;
 4. information about the Customer's use of services provided electronically.
8. T.RIVERWOOD is the administrator of personal data within the meaning of the Personal Data Protection Act, and a collection of personal data has been submitted to the Inspector General for the Protection of Personal Data.

CHAPTER II - TECHNICAL ISSUES

1. Information contained in system logs may contain other data.
2. T.RIVERWOOD uses them exclusively for technical purposes and for collecting general statistical information. The above information may be provided to entities authorized under applicable law.
3. T.RIVERWOOD may use cookies, which are text files that are stored on the Client's computer, identifying it in the manner necessary to enable certain operations. Cookies are used, among other things, to store data necessary for Client logins. The condition of cookies is their acceptance by the browser and not to remove them from the disk.

CHAPTER III - COMMERCIAL INFORMATION

1. Personal data of Customers may be used by T.RIVERWOOD for marketing purposes, and in particular for the transmission of newsletters electronically, only upon the Customer's consent to such processing.
2. In the case of personal data processed by T.RIVERWOOD for purposes other than those necessary to provide services, Customer may request T.RIVERWOOD to cease processing its personal data. Such request is immediately taken into consideration by T.RIVERWOOD.
3. All advertising material related to T.RIVERWOOD's activities and its contractors may be sent to the Customer only with his consent, in accordance with Art. 10 of the Act of 18 July 2002 on the provision of services by electronic means (Journal of Laws 2002, No. 144, item 1204, as amended).

CHAPTER IV - ACKNOWLEDGE

1. The termination of the contract or the withdrawal of the personal data by the Customer is voluntary and may be made at any time by sending an e-mail with the appropriate content to the e-mail address: office@riverwood.eu. Termination of the service contract by electronic means or withdrawal of consent to process personal data results in the removal of the Client's Account.
2. The Client's account is automatically deleted after 365 days of inactivity
